This "Policy" applies to cookies and relates to how they are used on the website: www.3dbistro.com

Definitions

Administrator: 3D Bistro Sp. z o. o., entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court Poznań - Nowe Miasto and Wilda in Poznań VIII Economic Department of the National Court Register, under KRS number 0000782541, NIP: 7831800669, REGON: 3831368432.

Cookies: computer data, small text files, recorded and stored on the Devices through which the User uses the Administrator's website.

Terminal Device - an electronic device through which the User accesses the Administrator's website, such as a computer, tablet, smartphone, etc.

User - means an entity using the Administrator's website for which electronic services may be provided or with which an Electronic Services Agreement may be concluded.

What are cookies?

Cookies should be understood as IT data, in particular text files, stored in the users' terminal equipment intended for the use of websites. These files allow to recognize the user's device and appropriately display the website adapted to his individual preferences. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the time they are stored on the end device and a unique number.

In principle, cookies do not allow to determine the identity of individuals, but only to identify the computer and browser. Because of the care with which we take to protect personal data, the protection measures provided for personal data are applied to these files. Storing cookies in your browser's memory has no negative impact on your software or hardware. A cookie only allows the information it contains to be read by the server from which it originated.

We make every effort to ensure that the use of cookies on the Site is safe for your computer. The use of cookies does not imply the collection of confidential information from you. Simply storing or accessing cookies does not cause configuration changes to your device.

When you visit the Site for the first time using a particular device, you will be shown information about the use of cookies along with a request to agree to their use.

What are cookies used for?

Cookies are used to adapt the content of the website to your preferences and to optimize the use of the website, including:

recognizing Users' devices and displaying the website appropriately;

adapting and optimizing the website to the needs of Users, remembering preferences regarding the website (language, its color, layout, distribution of content);

to create anonymous, aggregated statistics that help to understand how the User uses the website, which allows to improve its structure and content, excluding personal identification of the User;

To ensure the safety and reliability of the website.

What types of "cookies" do we use and how long are they stored?

We use the following types of "cookies":

session cookies - these are temporary information stored in the memory of your browser until your session ends, i.e. you close your browser. These cookies therefore work during your visit to our website, after which they are automatically deleted. They are necessary for the proper operation of certain functionalities on the website.

Persistent cookies - after you visit our website, they remain on your computer along with memorized information, e.g. about your configured computer set-up, and restore the settings during your next visits, making the use of our website easier for you. These files are stored for a maximum of 30 days.

Deleting cookies

By default, your web browsing software allows cookies to be placed on your terminal device. These settings can be changed so as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of your web browser or inform you each time they are sent to your device. Detailed information about the possibility and methods of handling cookies is available in the settings of your software (web browser).

You can also express, or withdraw your previously expressed consent to the use of cookies by the service at: print@3dbistro.com.

Restricting the use of cookies, may affect some of the functionality available on the website.
